



Packing List and Dress Code

To Be Shared with Students and Parents



Students represent both their home communities and PANIM: The Institute for Jewish Leadership and Values as they participate in seminars and retreats. As part of the Washington, DC experience, we ask that all students follow the guidelines listed below.

Standard Items to Pack:

- ☼ Socks, underwear, etc.
- ☼ Pajamas
- ☼ Sneakers/comfortable walking shoes - highly recommended
- ☼ Dress Shoes
- ☼ Toiletries: Shampoo, toothbrush, etc.
- ☼ Umbrella/raincoat - highly recommended
- ☼ Backpack - highly recommended
- ☼ Camera/Film
- ☼ Extra glasses/contact lenses
- ☼ Prescription medication - if applicable
- ☼ Items to distribute to homeless people
- ☼ **OPTIONAL:** Religious articles: *siddur*, *kippa*, *tallit*, *t'fillin* - to participate in prayer services
- ☼ **OPTIONAL:** Spending money
- ☼ **OPTIONAL:** Tzedakah money (\$5.00 recommended)

During the seminar "*****" we will be hitting the streets to speak with and distribute items to homeless people. Please bring socks, gloves, t-shirts, and/or toiletries to donate.

What to Wear in Washington:

The dress code for *Panim el Panim* seminars is business casual. Keep in mind Washington weather is always unpredictable no matter what season it is! Its always a good idea to check the weather before you travel.
