Trek West USA // \$5,150 - 9th - 12th grade

A grand adventure and tour in the American West. Teens travel through California, Nevada, Utah and Arizona - exploring the national park marvels of Yosemite, Zion, Bryce and the Grand Canyon; volunteering at a world-renowned shelter for abused dogs; experiencing the very best of Los Angeles and San Francisco; and coming away with a deep appreciation for the richness of America.

Northwest Connect // \$4,250 - 7th - 8th grade

Middle School teens travel from Seattle to San Francisco - exploring the rugged Pacific beaches and trendy cities of Washington, Oregon, and northern California; walk in the shadow of the redwood trees, raft on the Columbia River Gorge; and visit the campus of Microsoft and Amazon. Along the way, they explore the national park marvels of Olympic, Mt. Rainier and Crater Lake.

Southwest Connect // \$4,250 - 7th - 8th grade

Middle School teens travel from San Francisco to Phoenix - exploring the cities and natural wonders of California, Nevada, Utah, and Arizona; walk across the Golden Gate Bridge, stay at a dude-ranch and kayak on Lake Tahoe. Along the way, they explore the national park marvels of Yosemite, Zion, Bryce and the Grand Canyon.

Pacific Connect // \$7,800 - 7th - 8th grade

Middle School teens combine Northwest and Southwest Connect for an extraordinary four-week summer adventure. Traveling from Seattle to Phoenix, going on breathtaking hikes, exploring new cities, giving back on local service projects and bonding with new friends on the ultimate road trip.

CLTC is designed for AZA and BBG members who want to learn how to build and strengthen their chapter. At CLTC, teens have fun with peers from across North America, form mock chapters and together learn specific skills that will help them strengthen and lead their chapter at home. A typical day at CLTC includes leadership classes, "how to" sessions, evening programs, chapter planning and supervised free time. As a part of the CLTC community, they grow personally as they develop as a leader and explore their Jewish identity. This is the ultimate introductory Summer Experience for a teen who wants to be more involved in BBYO.

ILTC at Perlman Camp // \$2,800 - 10th - 12th grade

June 26 - July 13, 2014

ILTC is designed for AZA and BBG members who want to shape their community and are, or aspire to be, council, regional or International leaders. At Perlman Camp, teens strengthen their leadership skills and learn new ideas and tools to implement at home. At the end of ILTC, participants will have expanded their AZA and BBG network to include teens from around the world and know how to build and lead a teen movement and navigate the path towards becoming involved with BBYO Internationally.

Kallah at Perlman Camp // \$2,950 - 10th - 12th grade

July 14 - August 3, 2014

Kallah offers a meaningful Judaic experience where teens are given the opportunity to explore their Jewish identity and engage with spirituality, culture and religion. Teens are introduced to the variety of ways they can connect to Jewish life no matter what their interests are. No topic is off limits, and no opinion is taboo, when participants learn as much from their teachers as they do from each other.
