### EXPECTATIONS OF WISCONSIN REGION SRC COORDINATORS

Any applicants for Coordinator positions should be ready, willing, and EXCITED to meet the following expectations:

- To adhere to all deadlines and timeframes agreed upon by you and the BBYO staff.
- To rise to the very high standards Wisconsin has for its SRC programs, recognizing that Wisconsin doesn't settle for mediocrity and that adherence to deadlines is a critical part of a Regional event's successful operation.
- To realize that it's likely, if appointed, that you'll be coordinating this program with other BBYO members - and with BBYO staff - realize you must be able to work together in a professional manner with these people.
- Be willing and able to prioritize previous obligations and extra-curricular activities when it's "crunch time" for SRC.
- To realize that it's likely, if appointed, that you'll be coordinating this program with someone who isn't your friend and whom you might not even know right now. Be open-minded and flexible when working with your co-Coordiators, recognizing each other's strengths and weaker areas. Help each other, support each, strive to get along, and truly work as a team.
- To think of truly innovative programming ideas rather than falling back on the "same old, same old." Be willing to have ideas constructively criticized when necessary or picked apart, and rethought completely if needed...and to also understand this is done with the intention of making the program and event stronger.
- To understand that BBYO, first and foremost, is a JEWISH organization. To incorporate Judaism whenever possible into the Regional event's programming and overall "vibe."
- To show respect and passion for our religion and heritage, and to think of ways to communicate those via the Regional program being coordinated.
- To recognize that as a Coordinator, you set the example to which others in Wisconsin aspire.
- To be honest and accountable for your actions to staff, each other, and yourself.
- Respect the staff they are here to help and guide you.
- To work hard but to also have a lot of FUN!
