## What to Wear in Washington, DC

### For women:

- Shirts, blouses or sweaters; Nice pants, or skirts or dresses of an appropriate length; Dress Shoes

### For men:

- Button down shirts, polos or sweaters; slacks or khaki pants; Dress Shoes

**Service Day:** Casual clothing that can get dirty for your service project. You must wear closed toed-shoes, sneakers recommended.

**Lobby Day:** Dress for Success Clothing Day – Suits, ties, Dresses and skirts of an appropriate length. .
